Introduction

- The UPC created the Academic Staff Mobility Office in April 2003.
- The main aim was to facilitate transfer of researchers to and from the University.
- The reasons to create such an office:
 - An Institutional concern for supporting and improving the research activity at the UPC
 - The conviction that mobility plays a key role in research training and in the development of the knowledge society
 - The fear that the tedious and frustrating legal and administrative procedures could dissuade researchers from inviting their colleagues or could dissuade researchers from moving to our university.

Mission

Contribute to the internationalitazion of the UPC by:

A. Promoting and facilitating the international mobility of the staff of our university and

B. Promoting and facilitating the international mobility of foreign researchers and administrative staff to our university

Main Objectives

To promote the mobility of foreign academic staff, by facilitating the integration of the visiting staff and their families into the University and the city.

To foster the mobility of the UPC's research staff by providing advice and support to encourage them to undertake research visits to other countries.

To promote mobility by advertising and managing public and private mobility calls.

A. Academic Mobility (Adm. & Legal Issues)

Services provided to incoming academics:

- An electronical pack welcoming him/her and containing information about the legal procedures to be follow before arriving in Spain and about our institution.
- We take all the necessary steps so that the researcher can get the work permit.
- We apply for residence permits to their families.
- We offer a welcome session
- We help visitors to deal with procedures and contacts outside UPC to ease their move to the city (accommodation, registration at the town hall, schools, health care, etc...)
- Information about taxes, health insurance...
- We accompany and help them to follow formalities they have to carried out once in Barcelona.
- Information about language courses, cultural activities, etc..

A. Academic Mobility (Adm. & Legal Issues)

- Services provided to foreign researchers in Barcelona
- Renew their permits to live and work in Spain
- Modify their situation (from students to researchers)
- To get working permits for students
- Fix their illegal situation

A. Academic Mobility (Adm. & Legal Issues)

- Services provided to the outgoing UPC's academics:
- Current information about the different kind of public and private calls for mobility programs
- To help our academic staff to take all the necessary steps to obtain the grants offered in the mobility programs
- To inform them about all the legal procedures and formalities they have to carry out to enter the host country
- To contact the hosting University, especially the housing service.
- > etc...

Assesment

- Each individual presents a unique case that requires personal treatment.
- This fact has helped us to adapt the services to the needs of the incoming researchers
- Services requested by visiting researchers: most of them request all the services we offer.
- The contacts we have made with the Institutions involved and the careful monitoring of each case have allowed us to reduce the average time required to obtain a visa from 6-8 months to 2-3 months.
- We have improved the relations with all the Public Institutions involved
